

Checking components for H.M.S Fly.

(Kit purchased October 2010)

Items using 5mm Plywood, 1mm Plywood, 5mm Walnut, 3mm Walnut and 1.5mm Walnut Ply, which are Part Nos. 1 – 145 and 282 to 287 are easily checked by ensuring the ply sheets are complete.

Items using 0.25mm Brass Etch, 0.5mm Brass Etch, which are Part Nos. 147 to 213 are easily checked by ensuring the brass sheets are complete.

Part Nos. 248 to 261 can easily identified with common sense and a rule!

Part Nos. 214 to 246, 262 to 281, 288 to 290 and Part No.300 contained in the three plastic trays can be confusing to identify.

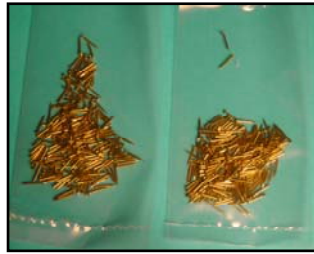

Identifying Part Nos. 240, 241, 242, 243 and 245 needs great care; thread thicknesses itemised in the instructions are only approximate. The difference between 241 and 242 is marginal, and a micrometer was used to determine the thread thickness. Figures in brackets on the label are the thread diameters determined with the micrometer.

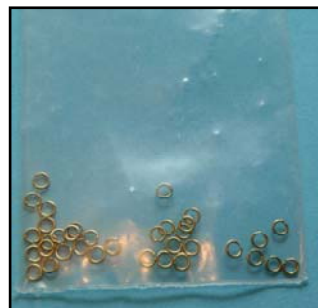
